Elite – A: Three (3) rounds of three (3) minutes, one (1) minute break between rounds.

<u>Senior</u> – B&C: Three (3) rounds of three (3) minutes, one (1) minute break between rounds.

Youth – A: Three (3) rounds of three (3) minutes, one (1) minute break between rounds.

Youth - B&C: Three (3) rounds of three (3) minutes, one (1) minute break between rounds.

<u>Junior</u> – A, B&C: Three (3) rounds of three (2) minutes, one (1) minute break between rounds.

5. SCORING SYSTEM

AIBA Scoring System - The 10-point scoring system will be in place.

6. REGISTRATION OF ARBITRATORS AND JUDGES

7. REGISTER OF BOXERS AND BOXING TEAMS

- a. **Go to https://mtkboxhost.com** and register your Boxing Club.
- b. Once registered, all your male and female Boxers enter your Boxing Club.
- c. Once you have entered all your participating boxers into your club, you can now go to the selected event (Lonsdale MTK Box Cup Spain) and enter your boxers from your club list.
- d. You can manage from here your category and class of KG Boxers entered to the cut-off point in the latest sign update 12-05-2022.
- e. After this, the tournament closes for tickets.









8.REQUIREMENTS

- a. All boxers must bring with them:
- Record book with the annual doctors duly completed and updated
- b. Each team delegation will bring the following:
- National flag 2 x 1.5 m
- National anthem (on MP3 or CD)
- c. Boxer uniform:
- Each boxer must bring their own red headguard for the red corner, and blue headguard for the Blue Corner AIBA Stamped.

9.TRANSPORT

All delegates arriving at *Valencia International Airport* will be accompanied by the staff of the Organizing Committee and will be transported to the central delivery point and hotels through the Provided Buses.

The Organizing Committee will provide local transportation to all participants between the airport and the hotel and the competition venue free of charge.

The schedules will be distributed near the time of arrivals.

Each Boxing Club entering from outside Spain will arrange and pay for travel arrangements for its athletes and/or officials from their country to and from *Valencia International Airport* to their country.

a. <u>Distance Valencia International Airport to Competition Venue</u>:

(35 miles / 56 km about 30-35 minutes trip).

COVID-19 PROTOCOL FOR TEAM DELEGATIONS

All official members of the Team Delegations, whether competitors or personal, international or local are obliged to:

- a. Present, upon arrival, an <u>individual medical certificate of COVID-19 (PCR test performed within 48 hours prior to arrival) with a negative result or the complete COVID vaccine.</u>
- b. At the request of the Spanish Ministry of Health, we inform you that anyone from countries of the European Union, associated Schengen area and third countries, has to fill out a registration hosted on the website of the Ministry of Health:

- c. Designate a COVID-19 contact person from the official team delegation list, who will be present during the Tournament and will monitor any COVID-19 related issues for your Team Delegation.
- d. Always wear a mask during the Tournament, with exceptions of:
 - i. boxers in training when it is not possible to use it
 - ii. participants in the respective hotel rooms, where is the choice of the participants
 - iii. participants during their meals only when they are sitting at their dining table
- e. Always observe social distancing (1.5 m), except for boxers during their bouts and during the warm-up with their trainer.
- f. Avoid entering the hotel rooms of other participants under any circumstances.
- g. Avoid any contact with people who are not on the training ground such as workers, other athletes...
- h. Undergo a non-contact temperature test by the LOC and/or local health authorities at any time during the Tournament
- i. Undergo COVID-19 testing at any time during the Tournament at the request of LOC COVID-19 Managers and/or local health authorities
- j. Follow all instructions from LOC's COVID-19 event managers, including isolation tracking, quarantine, observation procedures, and provision of detailed contact tracing should need be found.
- k. Timely report all violations of the COVID-19 protocol during the Event to COVID-19 managers
